Built bombs for suicide bombings and other terror attacks in which 67 people were murdered:

- Sbarro restaurant, Jerusalem, **15 people murdered** (Aug. 9, 2001)
- Zion Square, Jerusalem, **11 people murdered** (Dec. 1, 2001)
- Café Moment, Jerusalem, **11 people murdered** (March 9, 2002)
- Sheffield Club, Rishon Lezion, **15 people murdered** (May 7, 2002)
- The Hebrew University, Jerusalem, **9 people murdered** (July 31, 2002)
- Bus bombing in Tel Aviv, **6 people murdered** (Sept. 19, 2002)

Serving 67 life sentences in Israeli prison.

The Reward

Under Palestinian Authority law, the PA pays Barghouti and thousands of other terrorists monthly salaries while they are in prison.

Total PA salary since his arrest in March 2003 through December 2018:

\$200,496

(695,200 shekels)

Current salary of 7,300 shekels/month will increase until reaching 12,300 shekels/month, according to the PA pay scale on the reverse side.

PA Law

Under Palestinian Authority law, the PA pays every terrorist prisoner a monthly salary and has budgeted \$158 million (550 million shekels) in 2018 for terrorists' salaries.

Since 2000, the PA has raised the monthly salaries a number of times. Currently, every prisoner's salary starts at 1,400 shekels/month and increases every few years, reaching as high as 12,000 shekels/month after 30 years.

The following chart shows the monthly salaries in effect since January 2011.
